## ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS AND ENTRY CRITERIA

- Competitors must be current Itosu-ryu (Itosu-kai) members.
- Dan holders must have a Dan certificate issued by Soke Sadaaki Sakagami.
- Competitors cannot serve as referees.

## ENTRY FEE

USD 50 for all competitors per category incl. team

## SPECTATOR FEE

DKK 50,- per day per person

## REFEREES

- Kata referees (are Itosu-ryu appointed referees and are designated by IKIF (must be yondan or above in IKIF).
- Kumite referees are organized by the Danish Itosu-ryu organisation in collaboration with IKIF and supplemented by EKF/WKF appointed referees.
- Referee costume WKF modified.
- Itosu-ryu officials and referees must wear Itosu-kai emblem.
- Competitors must wear gi in accordance to WKF or JKF standards and Itosu-ryu competitors must wear Itosu-kai emblem on the chest.
- Registration by May 31st 2022 through Sportdata.

## ENTRY CRITERIA OF THE COMPETITION

- All entries must be done through Sportdata.org by May 31st 2022.
- Age is calculated as of August 4th 2022.

## COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

The competition will be held according to the current World Karate Federation Kata and Kumite of 01.01.2020 with some modifications:

- Individual kata: flag system - with repechage
- Team kata: flag system – no bunkai – with repechage
- Individual kumite: tournament style WKF - with repechage
- Team kumite: tournament style WKF – with repechage

The organizer reserves the rights to merge categories with few entries or conduct round robin tournament system (kumite)

## AWARDS

Medals will be given to 1st place, 2nd place and two 3rd places.

All participants and medal recipients will receive a certificate.

## SAFETY MEASURES

Medical staff will be available to treat injuries during the competition, but competitors are responsible for their own treatment after the competition. All participants and members of the delegations must arrange their own medical insurance and personal trip insurance. The organizing committee and host country is not liable for injuries, medical emergencies, or accidents.

## SAYONARA PARTY (HQ)

IKIF directors and referees are invited with no charge by the organizer. Participation price for other participants is USD 50 for adults and USD 30 for children aged 15 and under. Registration before May 31st, 2022 on Sportdata (number of participants). Payment by bank transfer.

## SOKE'S TECHNICAL SEMINAR

Cost USD 30. Registration on the day and payment in cash.

## VISA REQUIREMENTS

Participants from certain countries may require a visa to enter Denmark. It is each participant's responsibility to obtain a visa. However, the Organizing committee will send documentation that may be necessary to include in the visa application.

To send you an invitation letter, we will need the following information from you and your competitors **no later than June 15th**:

- Name
- Date of Birth
- Sex
- Nationality or citizenship
- Occupation
- Passport number
- Home address
- Arrival and departure date
- Place of stay while in Denmark

If you are unsure about the requirements, we advise you to contact the nearest Danish Embassy. Please be aware the visa applications can take.

Follow the QR code for information about the visa requirements for your country.



We recommend that you apply for a visa well in advance of your departure. You can apply maximum 6 months before your departure and at least 15 days before your entry into Schengen. Please note that if you submit your application less than 15 days before your entry into Schengen, the decision may be taken after your planned date of travel.
