- Referee/Officials meeting at 9.15am. Tatami officials will be announced at this meeting.
- Referees especially, must be in appropriate dress as per WKF rules. Judges, scorekeepers wear association tracksuit.
- Karate gi's must be white and should have IKKI crest. No other crests allowed other than makers name. All competitots must wear a gi.
- 3 tatami will be in operation.
- The tournament will commence immediately after club march in
- Categories may be amalgamated if numbers in a category are low
- Categories cannot consist of 1 competitor
- If a student withdraws, the withdrawal form must be used.
- Age is taken as competitors age on the 12th November 2023
- Medals for all 1st, 2nd and joint 3rd places
- Tournament fee: €20 and is non-refundable. Fees payable by clubs by or on Wednesday, 8th November. Revolut, bank transfer or any other means available.
- Any surplus funds will go towards the IKKI events fund

Safety is our greatest concern. On the tatami, it is the referee's responsibility.

IKKI training courses for tatami officials/Judges & Referees has been ongoing for several year with great success and attendance of these courses is vital to being selected to officiate at our National Championships. As usual we will hold referee/officials workshops prior to the tournament.

Referees/Officials workshop takes place:

The workshops are open to karateka 15 years and over and family of karateka who wish to be involved and help out at IKKI National Tournaments. Teamwork is essential on the day. Referees/Officials (teams) will be selected after the workshop. The first workshop was held on 30th September. A second workshop will be held before the tournament.

In the interest of safety:

WKF rules and IKKI referee/Judges/scorekeepers workshop must be adhered to, especially where fouls are concerned. This is of paramount importance. Specific WKF rules will apply to under 14 years of age.

Gum shields and mitts are compulsory for all competitors regardless of grade or age. Only competitors and officials will be allowed in the competition area.

Tuck shop (fundraiser)

There will be a tuck shop in operation during the competition. The tuck shop requires input from all the clubs to make it a success.

Squad Competitors:

Please list your kata and kumite squad competitors by name, age and rank so they can be assigned to meaningful categories as per entry sheet

Squad students kata: as for club students including: Kusanku-Dai, Kusanku-Sho, Seipai, Goju Shiho, Chinto, Unshu, Seinchin, Suparinpai, Nipaipo, Tomari Bassai and Tomari Wanshu.

Kata must be performed to IKKI tradition.

IKKI crest must be the only crest on the Gi besides the manufacturers.

Closing date for entries is Sunday 5th November 2023 No entries after this date

Please do not register competitors after the closing date and competitors arriving on the day who are not registered can't be facilitated.
